The old people help pick up the students after school. They also cook dinner for them and they help them with homework. All their work is free. They just want to do something helpful.

Yang Qiong is the starter of the program. She said the idea came from her experience. This 33-year-old woman has two children. Nobody looked after them when she and her husband were still at work. 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Can you imagine living all day in a cave? In March 2021, an experiment in France sent 15 volunteers into a cave for 40 days. The team had no phones, clocks or water in the cave.

During their time in the cave, the volunteers slept in a tent and used a bike to make electricity because there was no natural light. They also got water from a well which was about 45 meters underground. Since there was no sunlight, they had to follow their body clocks to know when to sleep and eat.

The experiment is part of a project called Deep Time. Its purpose is to see what will happen if people lose their sense of time. The experiment ended in April and the volunteers were given special sunglasses when they came out of the cave. This is because they saw sunlight for the first time in 40 days.

However, not all the volunteers were ready to get out of there. Two-thirds, in fact, loved it and wanted to keep going. Some said that they wanted to live there longer. "For once in our lives, we had time and could stop to live and do our own things. It was great." said one of them.

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As a teenager, you may sometimes feel helpless when having problems with your parents. Chen Zanzao, a 17-year-old from Shenzhen, has created a charity community called Dear Theodosia to help families facing similar problems professionally. It now

has 2,000 regular participants(定期参与者).

Chen's idea was inspired by the three-child policy. "My friend Sina and I thought it would bring problems. It would bring problems like parental favoritism (父母偏心), "Chen said. "Most families still don't know any methods to deal with this."

They started to research both scientific parenting styles and people's needs. They read a lot of literature and studies on the topic and surveyed more than 1, 000 people. They found that the most effective and healthy family relationships are when parents are highly engaged(参与的) in their children's lives.

They then founded the community to spread the idea. "We hold lectures and discussions as well as go on radio and TV programs to <u>promote</u> useful information," Chen said.

Chen and his friend Sina would do one-on-one conversations with people who felt self-conscious(难为情的) about sharing their stories. "It's understandable that at first, they need time to trust us since we are young, "Chen said. "But listening is the key and slowly, they will realize that we are professional."

"We met many parents saying, 'I never thought raising a child would be this difficult', so I think it's really important that parents think through whether they could take the responsibility before they rush into anything." Chen added.
