With most companies using the Internet to recruit and hire employees, it has become increasingly harder for job seekers to tell a genuine(真实的)job offer from a fake(虚假的)one.

While most people are not easy to fall into the job search traps(陷阱), others

may not be. But once you know what warning signs to look out for, you'll be much safer. Here are some signs to help you determine whether a job offer is a trap.

- 1. You're offered the job without an interview. If you're offered a job without even having an interview, alarm bells should be ringing!
- 2. The salary is higher than the market value. If the salary sounds completely unreasonable compared to the hours that you've been asked to do, then you're definitely a victim of a fake job offer.
- 3. The e-mail text is unprofessional. If the email doesn't read well to you, then chances are the offer is fake.
- 4. There's no company or contact information. If there's no professional email footer or any contact information, then it's likely that you're dealing with a fake job offer.
- 5. You're asked to transfer money. Anything involving money should be <u>a big red</u> flag.
- 6. You're asked to provide personal information. A fake job offer also asks you to provide your bank details, ID card and social insurance.

So, there you have it. These are the best ways to identify and avoid job search traps.
